

These categories are not mutually exclusive and the boundaries between classifications are frequently fuzzy. This schema is intended to facilitate the student's examination of MIS research and is not intended as a normative taxonomy. The following course bibliography is organized sequentially by research topic.

S601 MIS Research Topics in Application Systems Development

This course draws articles primarily from bibliography numbers 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 8, 13, 14, 17, 18, 19, and 20: those related to the development, implementation and use of information systems applications. Occasionally, articles used in this course may also be selected from the other categories. Frequently, articles will be assigned that are not currently included in any of the existing bibliographies.

S602 MIS Research Topics in Administration and Technology

This course draws articles primarily from bibliography numbers 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 15, 16, 18, 19 and 20: those related to administration and technology. Occasionally, articles used in this course may be selected from other categories. Frequently, articles will be assigned that are not currently included in any of the existing bibliographies.
