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# Uvodne besede

Ekonomska fakulteta je bila ustanovljena 8. 3. 1946 z odredbo slovenske vlade. Delovala je v prostorih v Gregorčičevi ulici 27. Prvo leto se je na fakulteto vpisalo 334 študentov, učni proces pa je fakulteta pričela z enim rednim učiteljem, enim lektorjem, enim asistentom ter devetimi honorarnimi predavatelji.

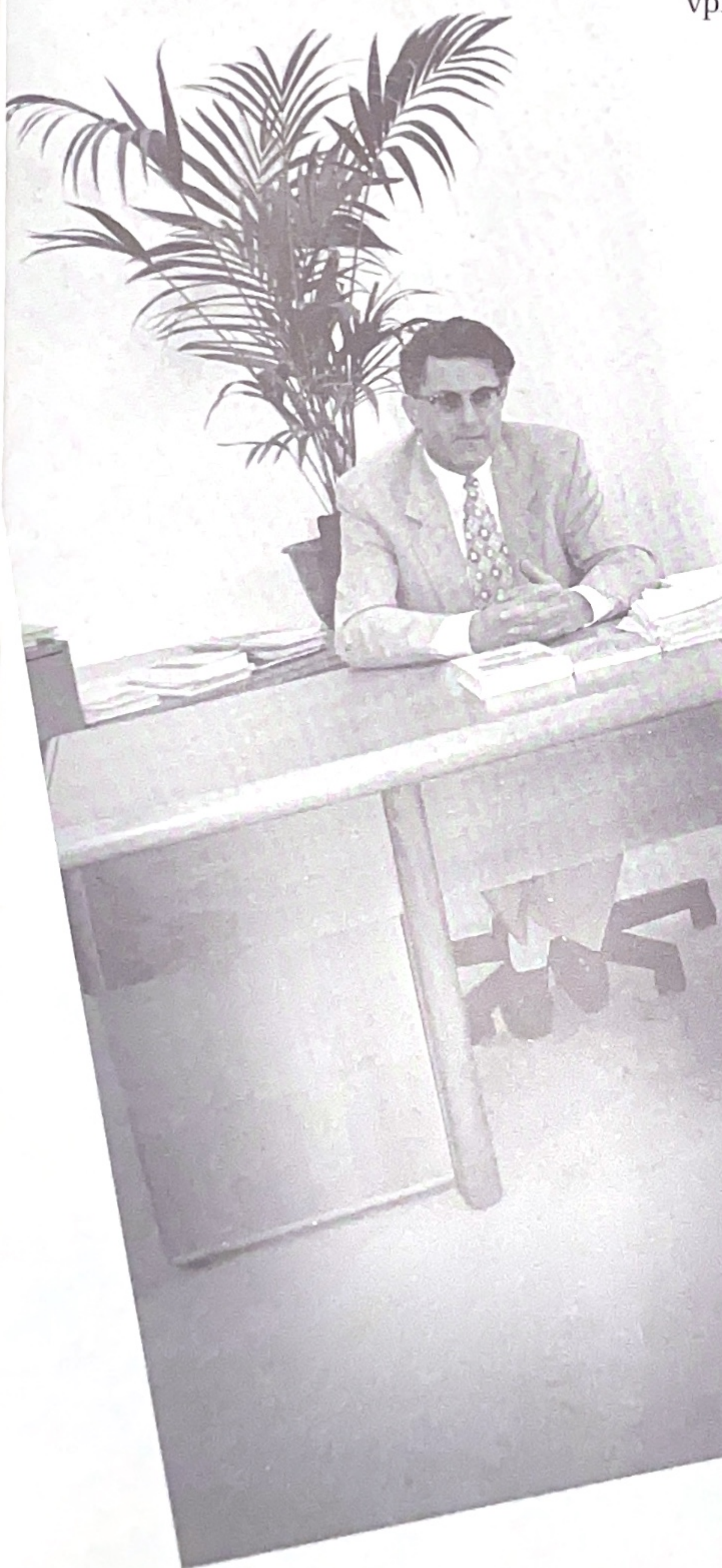
Število vpisanih študentov je do šolskega leta 1954/55 postopoma upadalo. Tega leta se je vpisalo le 248 študentov. Od šolskega leta 1954/55 pa število vpisanih študentov stalno narašča, tako da je bil od šolskega leta 1990/91 naprej vpis v prvi letnik omejen na 850 rednih študentov. Poleg tega pa se vsako leto vpiše v prvi letnik še okoli 1000 izrednih študentov v študijske centre v Ljubljani in drugod po Sloveniji. Fakulteta je pričela s študijskim procesom v sedanjih prostorih jeseni leta 1976.

Študenti se na fakulteti usposablajo za učinkovito vodenje podjetij, vodenje posameznih poslovno-organizacijskih področij oziroma za opravljanje del raziskovalno-analitičnega značaja. To jim zagotavlja obsežen fond teoretičnih, metodoloških in aplikativnih predmetov. Temeljni namen študija je razvijanje vodstvenih (managerskih) sposobnosti diplomantov oziroma sposobnosti za opravljanje visokostrokovnih del narodnogospodarske naravnosti.

Zaključen dodiplomski študij omogoča diplomantom nadaljevanje izobraževanja na podiplomski ravni (specializacija in magisterij) vse do doktorata znanosti. Vzporedno s pedagoškim delom pa fakulteta razvija znanstveno-raziskovalno dejavnost na temeljnih in aplikativnih področjih ekonomskih in poslovno-organizacijskih znanosti.

# Mednarodne povezave

Danes je Ekonomška fakulteta v Ljubljani sodoben visokošolski zavod, na katerem se izvajajo različni programi dodiplomskega, podiplomskega in doktorskega študija. V teh programih letno študira več kot 5 000 študentov. Študentom in skoraj stotim univerzitetnim učiteljem so za pedagoško delo namenjene 4 velike predavalnice ter 44 manjših predavalnic. Od teh je 6 posebej opremljenih za potrebe učenja tujih jezikov z avdio in video opremo, 5 pa s sodobno računalniško opremo. Fakulteta ima tudi knjižnico z dvema čitalnicama, več sejnih sob in restavracijo. V fakultetnem kompleksu deluje tudi Računalniški center univerze.

Ekonomška fakulteta že več desetletij vzdržuje stike s sorodnimi institucijami po svetu, posebno pa se je mednarodna dejavnost fakultete razširila v zadnjih letih. Najpomembnejše mednarodne povezave so:

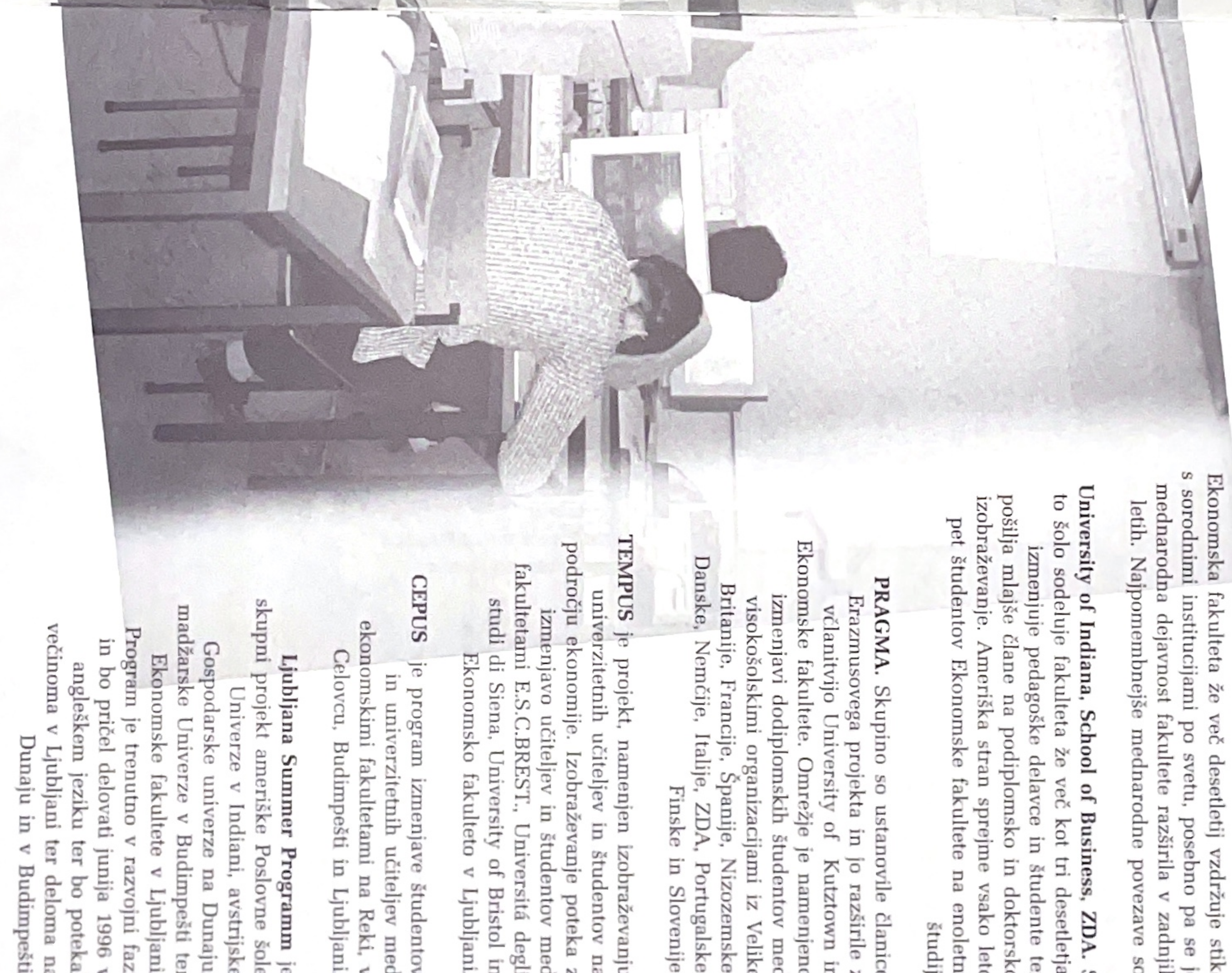
**University of Indiana, School of Business, ZDA.** S to šolo sodeluje fakulteta že več kot tri desetletja, izmenjuje pedagoške delavce in študente ter pošilja mlajše člane na podiplomsko in doktorsko izobraževanje. Ameriška stran sprejme vsako leto pet študentov Ekonomske fakultete na enoletni študij.

**PRAGMA.** Skupino so ustanovile članice Erazmusovega projekta in jo razširile z včlanitvijo University of Kutztown in Ekonomske fakultete. Omrežje je namenjeno izmenjavi dodiplomskih študentov med visokoškolskimi organizacijami iz Velike Britanije, Francije, Španije, Nizozemske, Danske, Nemčije, Italije, ZDA, Portugalske, Finske in Slovenije.

**TEMPUS** je projekt, namenjen izobraževanju univerzitetnih učiteljev in študentov na področju ekonomije. Izobraževanje poteka z izmenjavo učiteljev in študentov med fakultetami E.S.C.BREST., Universitá degli studi di Siena, University of Bristol in Ekonomsko fakulteto v Ljubljani.

**CEPUS** je program izmenjave študentov in univerzitetnih učiteljev med ekonomskimi fakultetami na Reki, v Celovcu, Budimpešti in Ljubljani.

**Ljubljana Summer Programm** je skupni projekt ameriške Poslovne šole Univerze v Indiani, avstrijske Gospodarske univerze na Dunaju, madžarske Univerze v Budimpešti ter Ekonomske fakultete v Ljubljani. Program je trenutno v razvojni fazi in bo pričel delovati junija 1996 v angleškem jeziku ter bo potekal večinoma v Ljubljani ter deloma na Dunaju in v Budimpešti.



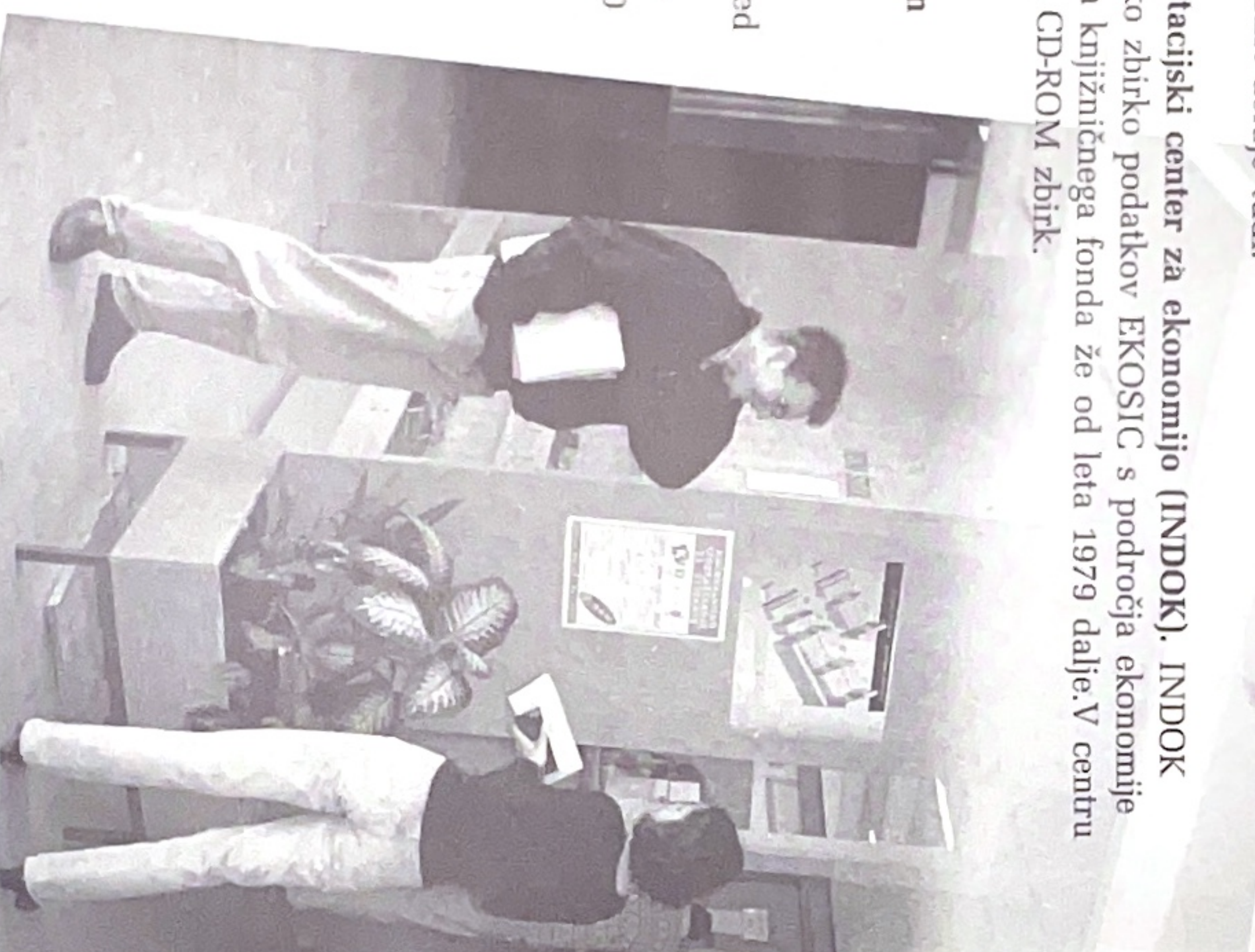
**Raziskovalni center Ekonomske fakultete (RCEF)** je organizacijska enota, v okviru katere se razvija raziskovalno delo na Ekonomski fakulteti. Temeljni namen RCEF-a je opravljanje temeljnih in uporabnih raziskovalnih projektov na področju ekonomskih, poslovnih in informacijsko-upravljalških znanosti, svetovanje podjetjem, organizacijam in družbenim organom ter pomoč pri vzgoji znanstvenega naraščaja. Ta cilj uresničuje RCEF z organizacijo raziskovanja fakultetnih učiteljev in asistentov, z načrtovanjem in usmerjanjem raziskovalnega dela, z objavljanjem izsledkov raziskovalne dejavnosti, z organizacijo posvetov, s strokovnim izpopolnjevanjem sodelavcev, s sodelovanjem z drugimi raziskovalnimi institucijami, z navezovanjem stikov in sodelovanjem s podjetji ter z vzdrževanjem stikov med domačimi in tujimi strokovnjaki.

**Centralna ekonomska knjižnica (CEK)** je največja knjižnica za področje ekonomije in poslovnih ved v Sloveniji ter tudi članica European Business Schools Librarians' Group (EBSLG). Poleg izposoje svojega fonda posreduje informacije in medbibliotečno izposajo iz drugih knjižnic in centrov doma in v tujini. Fond knjižnice obsega preko 215 000 enot. Uporabnikom so na voljo različni računalniški in klasični katalogi ter katalogi drugih knjižnic v Sloveniji. V okviru CEK deluje tudi:

**Specializirani informacijsko-dokumentacijski center za ekonomijo (INDOK).** INDOK gradi lastno specializirano bibliografsko zbirko podatkov EKOSIC s področja ekonomije in z njo povezanih znanosti iz svojega knjižničnega fonda že od leta 1979 dalje. V centru nudijo tudi informacije iz osmih tujih CD-ROM zbirk.

**Center strokovnega izpopolnjevanja in svetovalne dejavnosti Ekonomske fakultete (CISEF)** je največji univerzitetno poslovno-izobraževalni center v Sloveniji. Predstavlja most med fakulteto in gospodarstvom. V obliki seminarjev, delavnic, tečajev, posvetov in šol se lahko izobražuje več kot 2500 direktorjev, managerjev in strokovnih delavcev iz podjetij, bank in drugih ustanov. Osnovna področja izobraževalnih programov so: ekonomika, finance, bančništvo, splošni management, marketing, računovodstvo, upravljanje s človeškimi viri ter tuji jeziki.

Izobraževalni programi se delijo na programe odprtega tipa in programe za zaključene skupine, izdelane po naročilu podjetja. V njih pa sodeluje preko 50 strokovnjakov, od katerih je slaba polovica univerzitetnih učiteljev, ostali pa so zunanji sodelavci.



**Podatkovno analitični servis Ekonomske fakultete (PASEF)** je center znanja, katerega cilj je zgraditi sistem za industrijsko produkcijo multimedialnih informacijskih produktov, predvsem za potrebe ekonomije in poslovnih ved. Center zato pridobiva, preizkuša, sistematično skladišči in daje v uporabo na uporabniku prijazen način vse vrste številčnih podatkov, tekstovnih ter video in avdio informacij. Sistem je v pomoč pri izdelavi seminarjskih nalog, diplom, magistrskih nalog, disertacij, učnih gradiv, knjig, člankov, multimedialnih predstavitev, telekonferenc, telepredavanj, ... Vse informacije, programska oprema in navodila so dostopne preko računalnikov PASEF-a, v kratkem času pa bodo dostopne tudi preko modema, Interneta in na CD-ROM-ih.

**Evropski dokumentacijski center (EDC)** je od marca 1990 s strani Komisije Evropske unije pooblaščen informacijsko-dokumentacijski in depozitarni center za gradiva in dokumente Evropske unije (EU) v Sloveniji. Osnovne naloge EDC so pridobivanje, strokovna obdelava, hranjenje in zagotavljanje prostega dostopa do literature, dokumentov in informacijskih virov o EU ter nudenje kvalitativnih informacij in storitev. V EDC so dostopne publikacije in gradiva, ki jih izdajajo institucije EU (Evropska komisija, Evropski parlament, Evropski svet, Evropsko sodišče, Evropski socialni in ekonomski komite), Svet Evrop, Evropski sklad za izboljševanje življenjskih in delavnih razmer, Evropski inštitut za javno upravo (Maastricht) in druge podobne institucije. Poleg teh pa so na voljo tudi različne mikrofilmske izdaje, podatki na CD-ROM-ih ter domače in tuje (Eurobases) on-line baze podatkov.

**Enota za založništvo.** Ekonomska fakulteta letno izda več kot 60 naslovov različnih študijskih gradiv (učbenikov, skript, vaj, zapiskov predavanj, ...). Sem sodi tudi zbirka MAKSIME, ki je sestavljena iz knjižnih del učiteljev fakultete. S temi deli, ki izražajo leta raziskovalnega in pedagoškega dela, želijo avtorji in fakulteta svoja najboljša dela predstaviti širši javnosti, namenjena pa so seveda tudi študentom.

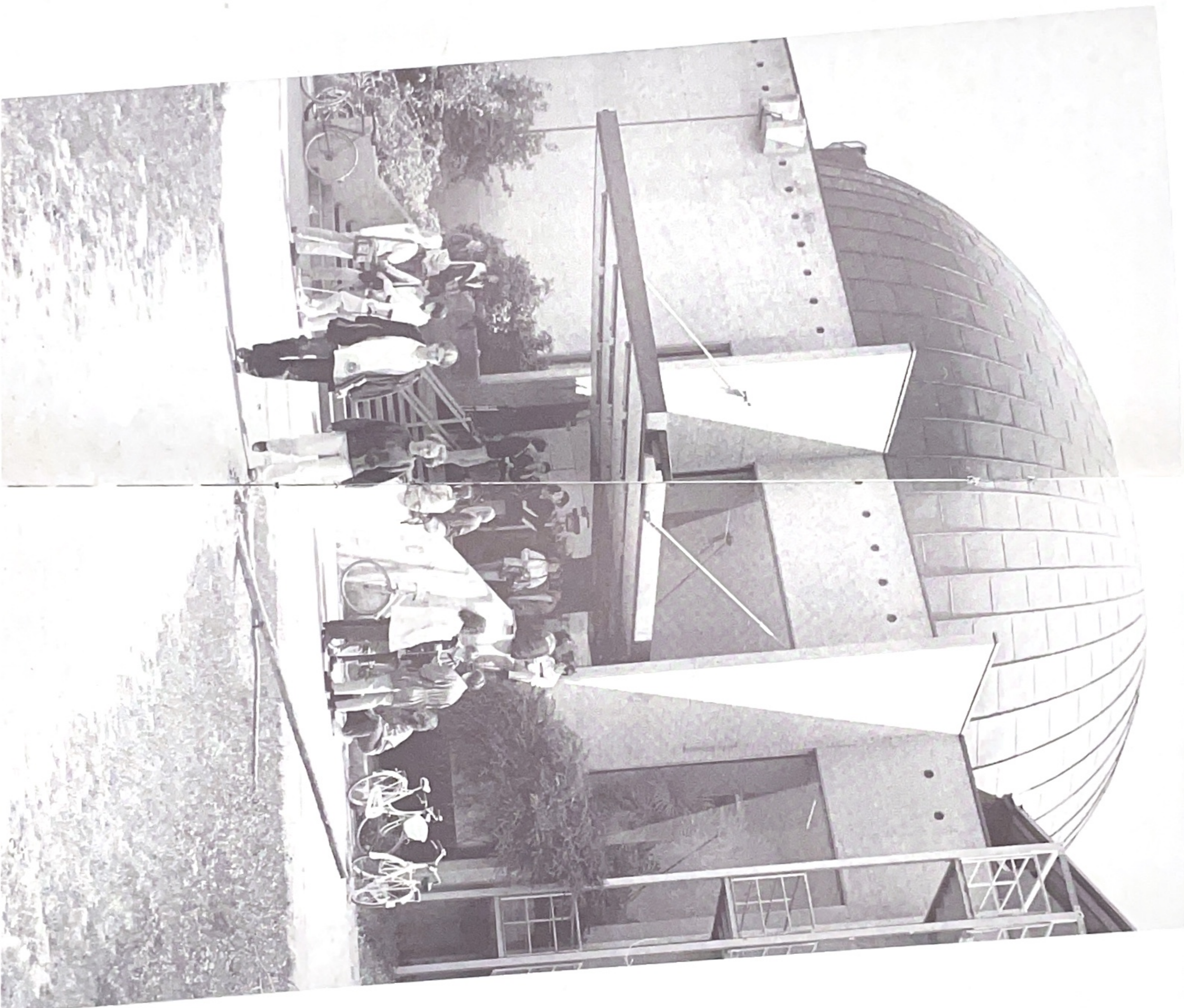
## Študentska organizacija

Ekonomska fakulteta izvaja na rednem študiju dva ločena programa :

- štiriletni študijski program za pridobitev visoke strokovne izobrazbe - VISOKA POSLOVA ŠOLA
- štiriletni študijski program za pridobitev univerzitetne izobrazbe - EKONOMIJA

Program EKONOMIJA izobražuje študente bolj teoretske ekonomske naravnosti, ki se usposabljaajo bodisi za delo visoke strokovne zahtevnosti raziskovalno-analitičnega značaja bodisi za učinkovito vodenje podjetij in drugih organizacij ter izvajanje poslovnih operacij doma in v tujini.

Program VISOKA POSLOVNA ŠOLA usposablja študente za takojšno praktično uporabo znanj, analitičnih postopkov in poslovnih tehnik in je tesno povezan s problemi poslovne prakse. Poleg analitičnih možnosti program izrazito razvija sposobnosti pogajanj, odločanja in realizacije sprejetih odločitev na vseh strokovnih in vodstvenih ravneh v različnih vrstah gospodarskih in drugih organizacij.

## IZREDNI ŠTUDIJ

Ekonomska fakulteta razpisuje kot izredni študij tri ločene programe:

V okviru posebnega PHARE projekta za regionalno sodelovanje deluje od leta 1994 na Ekonomski fakulteti Center za urejanje študija na daljavo v Sloveniji. V študijskem letu 1995/96 Ekonomska fakulteta začneja eksperimentalno izvajati študij na daljavo v 1. letniku VISOKE POSLOVNE ŠOLE v treh študijskih centrih v Novi Gorici, na Ptujju in v Trebnjem. Pri študiju na daljavo študent v glavnem študira samostojno iz posebej pripravljenih študijskih gradiv. Omogočeno pa mu je tudi komuniciranje preko računalniške mreže in občasno srečevanje z učitelji in tutorji v študijskih centrih. 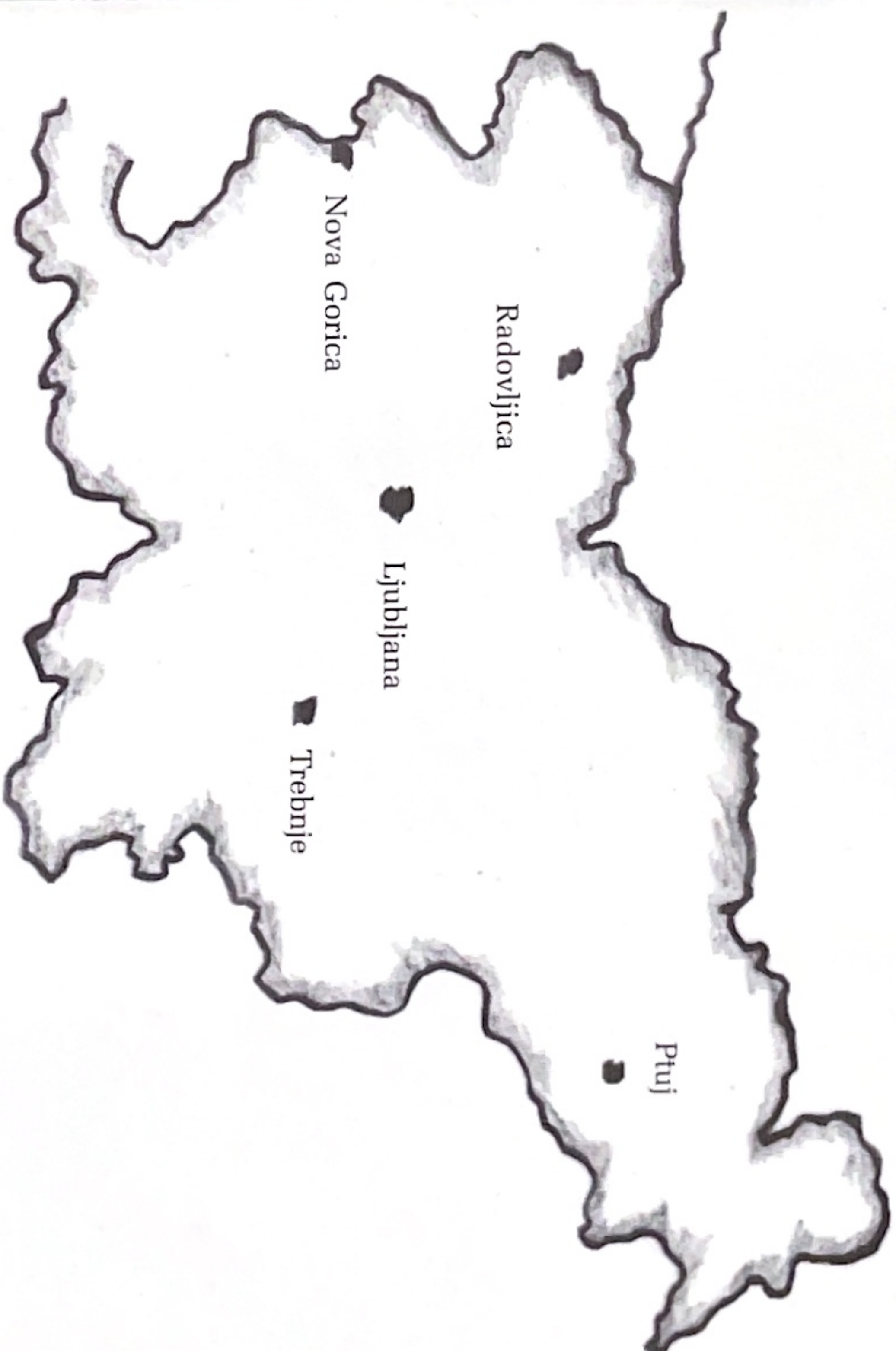

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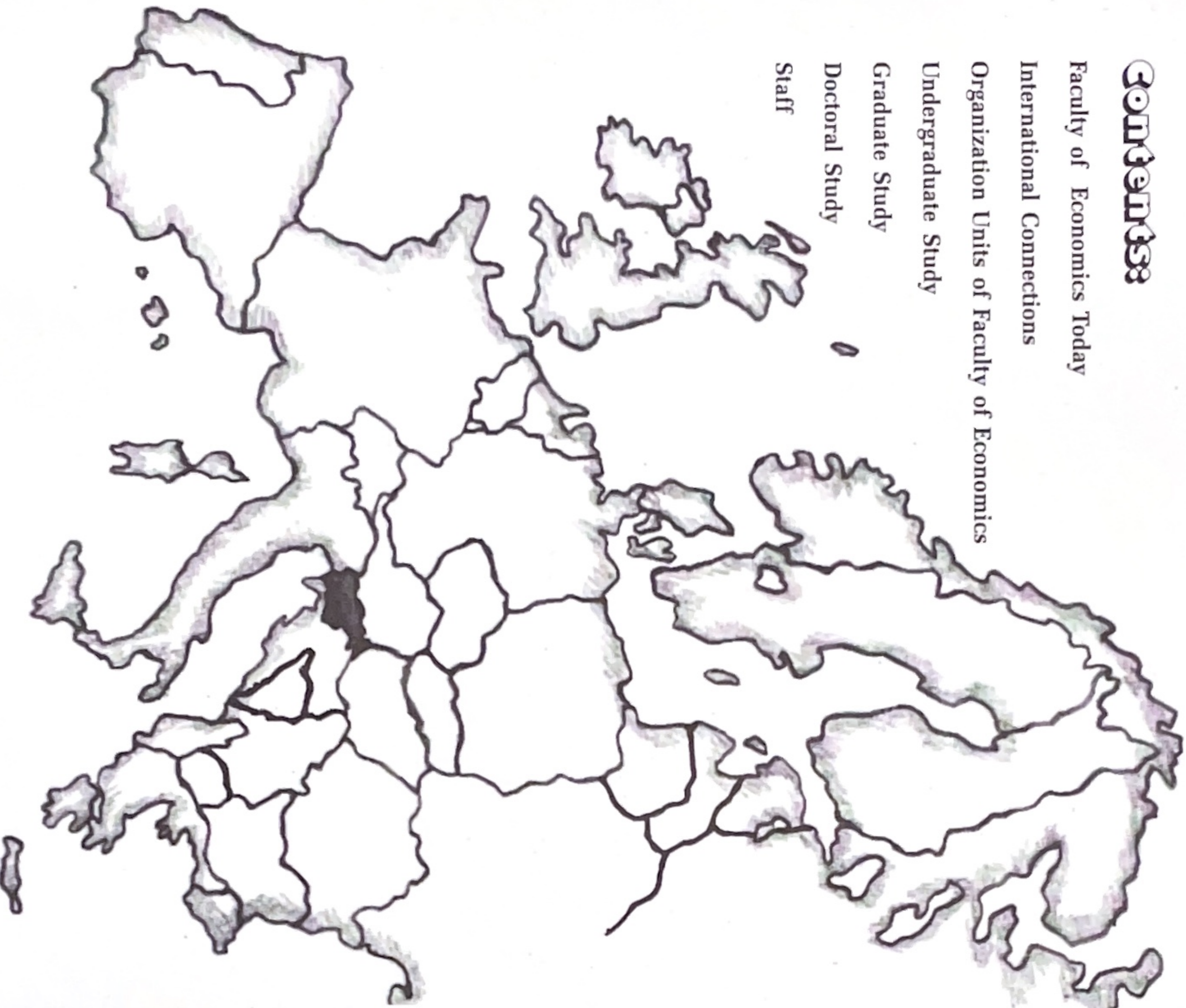

# INTRODUCTORY WORDS

The Faculty of Economics was founded on March 3, 1946 by a decree of the Slovene Government. It performed its activities in the premises in 27, Gregoričeva Street. In the first year 334 students enrolled to the Faculty, and the learning process began with one Full Professor, one Lecturer, one Assistant Professor and nine part-time Lecturers.

The number of enrolled students gradually decreased up to the academic year of 1954/55. In that year only 248 students enrolled. Since 1954/55 the number of enrolled students has been increasing so that, since the academic year 1990/91, the enrollment in the first year has been limited to 850 full-time students. Each year there are also about 1000 part-time students who enroll in the first study year at the study centres in Ljubljana and elsewhere in Slovenia. The Faculty began with its study process at the present location in autumn 1976.

The students are trained at the Faculty to manage companies efficiently, to manage individual business organizational fields, or to carry out research work and perform analytical tasks. This is guaranteed by a vast fund of theoretical, methodological and applicative know-how. The fundamental purpose of the study is to develop the graduates' leading (managerial) skills or the skills needed to perform highly professional work attuned to the national economy.

Completed undergraduate study enables graduates to continue their education at the graduate level (Specialization and Master's Degree) to Doctor of Philosophy Degree. In parallel with its pedagogical work the Faculty has been developing its scientific and research activities in the fundamental and applicative fields of Economics and Business Organization.

# Faculty of Economics Today

# International Connections

Today the Faculty of Economics in Ljubljana is a modern academic institution, performing various programmes of undergraduate, graduate and doctoral study. More than 5000 students study in these programmes per year. At the disposal of students and nearly a hundred university teachers there are 4 large lecture rooms and 44 smaller ones, six of which are specially equipped for the needs of foreign language teaching with audio and video equipment, while five of them have modern computer equipment. The Faculty has a library with two reading rooms, several conference rooms and a restaurant, too. In the Faculty complex there is also a University Computer Centre.

The Faculty of Economics has been maintaining its connections with related institutions worldwide for several decades, and the international activities of the Faculty have especially expanded in the past years. The most important international connections are the following:

**University of Indiana, School of Business, USA.** The Faculty has been cooperating with this school for more than three decades, exchanging pedagogical workers and students and sending younger members there for graduate and doctoral education. Each year the American side receives five students from the Faculty of Economics for one-year study.

**PRAGMA** group has been established by the members of Erasmus Project and expanded by the University of Kutztown and the Faculty of Economics becoming its members. The network is intended to exchange undergraduate students among higher education organizations from the United Kingdom, France, Spain, the Netherlands, Denmark, Germany, Italy, the USA, Portugal, Finland and Slovenia.

**TEMPUS** is a project intended for university teachers' and students' education in the field of economics. Education takes place by exchanging teachers and students among the faculties E.S.C. BREST., Università degli studi di Siena, University of Bristol and the Faculty of Economics in Ljubljana.

**CEPUS** is a programme of students' and university teachers' exchange among the Faculties of Economics in Rijeka, Klagenfurt, Budapest and Ljubljana.

**Ljubljana Summer Programme** is a joint project of the American Business School of the University in Indiana, the Austrian University of Economics in Vienna, the Hungarian University in Budapest, and the Faculty of Economics in Ljubljana. The programme is in its development stage at the moment and will start with its activities in June 1996 in the English language; it will take place mostly in Ljubljana, and partly in Vienna and Budapest.



# Organization Units of the

# Faculty of Economics

The **Research centre of the Faculty of Economics (RCEF)** is an organizational unit in the framework of which the research work at the Faculty of Economics has been developed. The basic purpose of RCEF is the performing of basic and applicative research projects in the field of Economics, Business, Informatics and Management, consultancy services to companies, organizations and social bodies, as well as help in the education of the young staff working in the field of science. RCEF has realized this objective by organizing the research of the Faculty's Professors and Assistant Professors, by planning and directing research work, publishing the findings of research activities, organizing conferences, by professional training of its staff, cooperation with other research institutions, by making contacts and cooperating with companies, as well as maintaining the contacts among foreign and domestic experts.

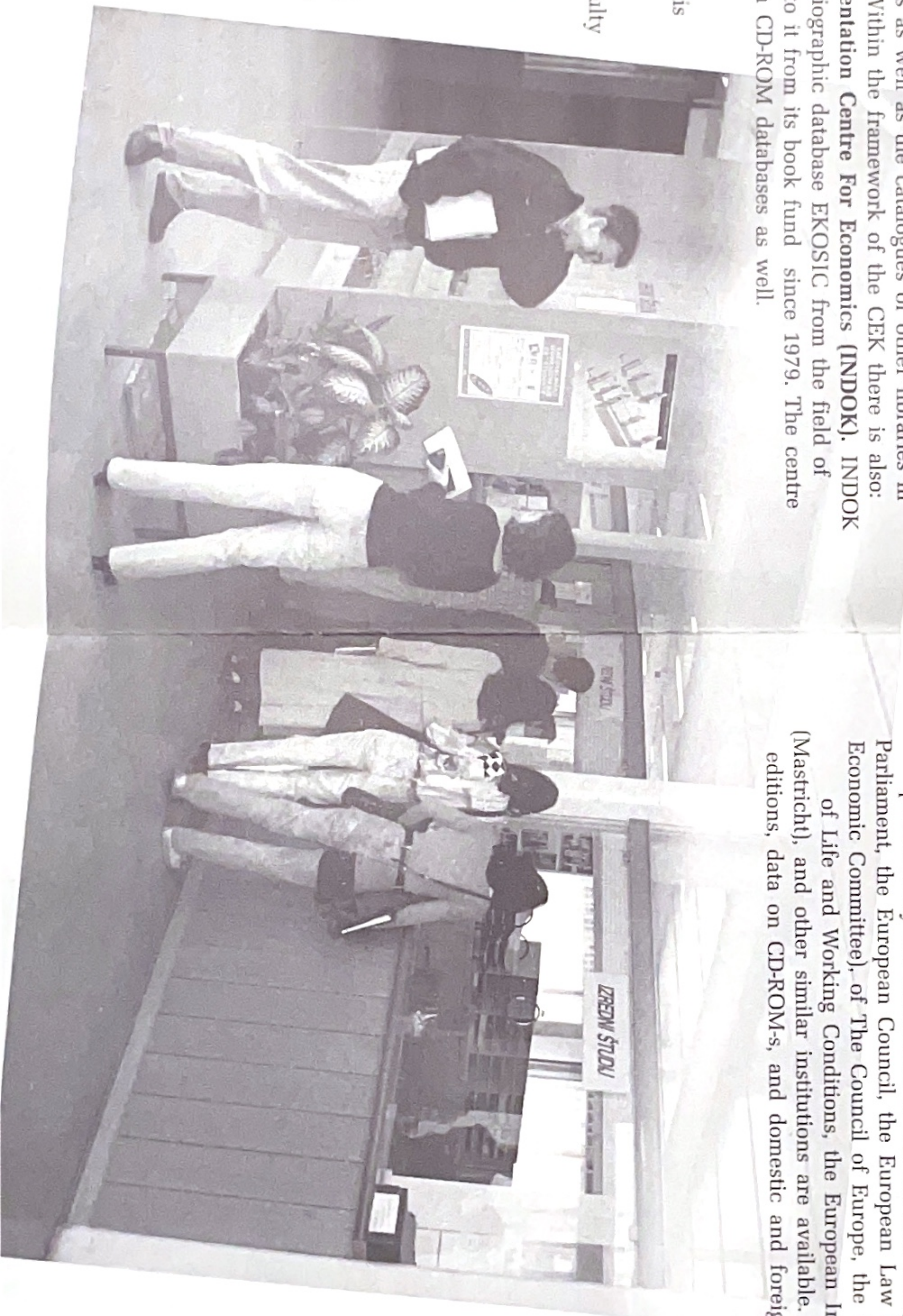
The **Central Economic Library (CEK)** is the biggest library in the field of Economics and Business in Slovenia and is a member of the European Business Schools Librarians' Group (EBSLG). Besides lending its reading resources, it mediates information and enables the lending of materials from other libraries and centres at home as well as abroad. The library's reading resources comprise more than 215,000 units. Various computerized and classical catalogues as well as the catalogues of other libraries in Slovenia are at the users' disposal. Within the framework of the CEK there is also: **The Specialized Information-Documentation Centre For Economics (INDOK)**. INDOK has been creating its specialized bibliographic database EKOSIC from the field of Economics and the sciences related to it from its book fund since 1979. The centre offers information from eight foreign CD-ROM databases as well.

The **Centre for Management Development and Training (CISEF)** is the biggest university business and educational centre in Slovenia. It represents a bridge between the Faculty and the economy. In the form of seminars, workshops, courses, conferences and schools, more than 2500 directors, managers and professional staff from companies, banks and other institutions have been trained. The basic fields of educational programmes are economics, finance, banking, general management, marketing, accounting, human resources management and foreign languages. Educational programmes are divided into open-type programmes and programmes for closed groups, which are tailor-made. More than 50 experts cooperate in them, of which slightly less than a half are the Faculty Professors while the others are visiting lecturers.

The **Data Analytical Service of the Faculty of Economics (PASEF)** is a centre of knowledge, the objective of which is to build a system for the industrial production of multimedia information products, especially for the needs of economics and business. Therefore the Centre acquires, tests, systematically stores and gives in usage all the types of numerical data, text, video and audio information in a user friendly way. The system helps with seminar work, work on undergraduate theses, master's theses and doctor's theses, learning materials, books, articles, multimedia presentations, teleconferences, telelectures, etc. All the information, programme equipment and instructions are available via PASEF's computers, and, shortly, they will also be available via modems, Internet and CD-ROM-s.

The **European Documentation Centre (EDC)** has been authorized by the Commission of the European Union as an information-documentation and deposit centre for materials and documents of the European Union (EU) in Slovenia since March 1990. The basic tasks of EDC are acquisition, professional processing, storage and providing free access to literature, documents and information sources on the EU, as well as providing information and services of high quality. In the EDC the publications and materials, published by the institutions of the EU (the European Commission, the European Parliament, the European Council, the European Law Court, the European Social and Economic Committee), of The Council of Europe, the European Fund of Improvement of Life and Working Conditions, the European Institute of Public Administration (Mastricht), and other similar institutions are available. Beside these, various microfilm editions, data on CD-ROM-s, and domestic and foreign (Eurobases) on-line databases are available, too.

The **Publishing Unit**. The Faculty of Economics publishes more than 60 titles of various study materials yearly (textbooks, lecture notes, exercises, etc.) Here also belongs the collection MAKSIME in which the Faculty Professors' works, published as books, are collected. With these works, expressing years of research and pedagogical work, the authors and the Faculty wish to present the best of their work to the broader public, but, of course, they are intended for students as well.

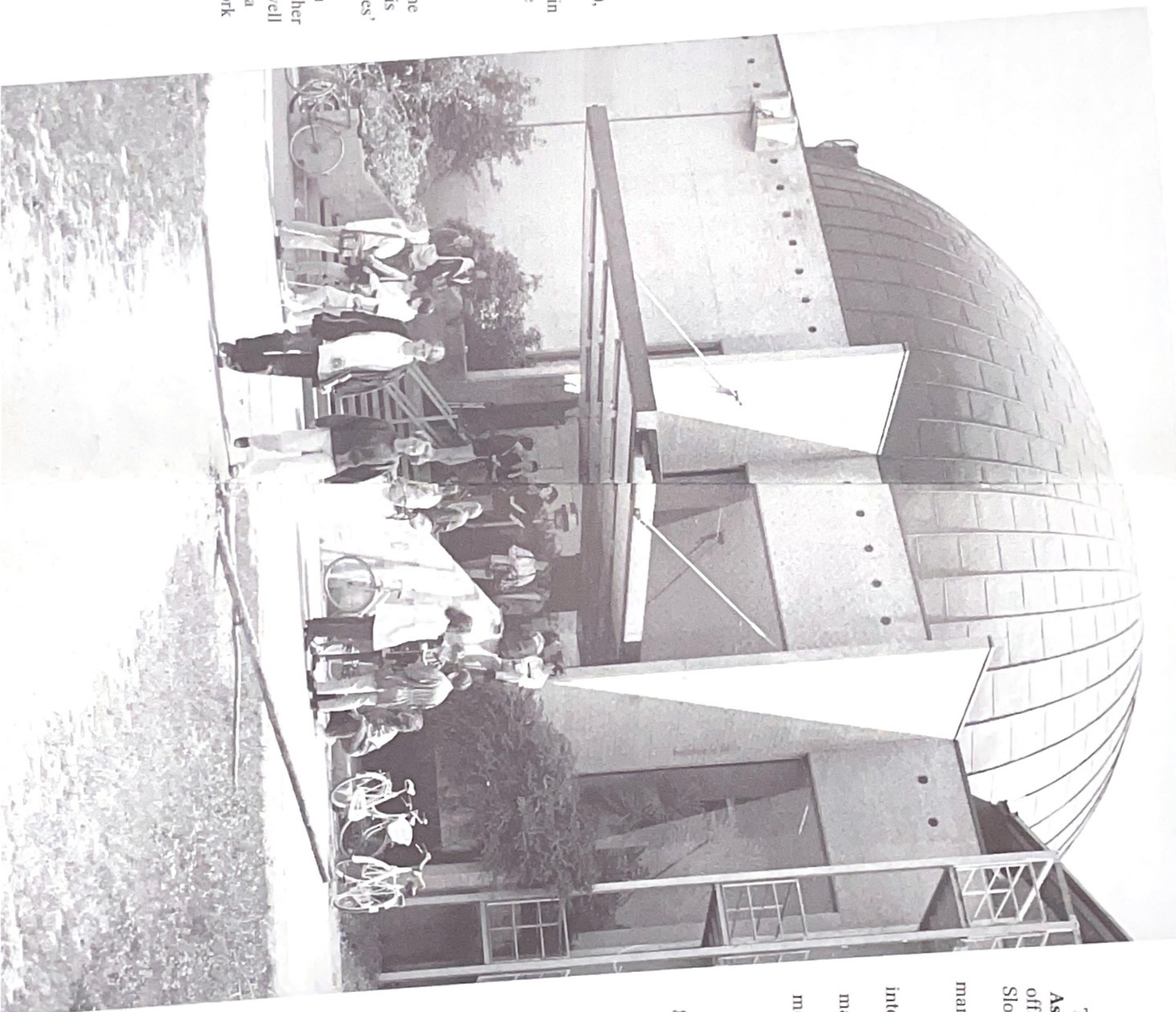
# Student Organizations

**Student organization of the Faculty of Economics (ŠOEF)** covers the most versatile domains among which the most important are the following:

- accompanying and evaluating of the study process, lecturers and study conditions
- connections with faculties at home and abroad, with special emphasis on the group Alpe-Adria.
- efforts to lower the prices of student food and study literature
- organization of different cultural and sports performances

**AIESEC** is an international association of students of Economics and Management active at 8000 faculties in 81 countries. Today AIESEC Ljubljana has over 80 active members, working within the framework of six teams (Projects, International Exchange of Practice, Marketing, Foreign Connections, Human Resources, Finance), and thus creating possibilities for them to acquire experiences, to actively incorporate young people in their social and economic environment, and enable them to meet and mutually cooperate with other young people of different cultures and nations.

**Expert Junior** is a project group of students of the Faculty of Economics, the basic activity of which is mediating students of Economics and other faculties' intellectual services to economy. The work is planned as project work, and doing it, students can make their knowledge, acquired at the Faculty, richer with practice. The projects run on a domestic as well as on an international level, since Expert Junior is a fully authorized member of the international network Junior Enterprise, joining such organizations worldwide.



**The Student Section of the Marketing Association of Slovenia (ŠS DMS)** is an offspring of the Marketing Association of Slovenia. The basic tasks of ŠS DMS are to educate and connect the future marketing elites. The connecting activities go in two directions, namely as the connection of the students seriously interested in marketing, and as students' connection with present day Slovene marketing practice. Education, however, is organized through regular monthly meetings, lectures and visits to different educational programmes.

**Management Group** is a group of students and younger graduates, the goal of which is to acquire knowledge of high quality from the field of Management and Entrepreneurship. Members can obtain training in the form of lectures and workshops, they can visit international and domestic fairs, congresses and symposiums, visit companies and make professional excursions. On the other hand, Management Group provides professional help and consultancy services to the companies interested in them.

**Student FORUM** is an entrepreneurial group of students of Economics that helps Slovene and foreign companies to organize meetings among company principal groups and students, undergraduates and graduates from Ljubljana University.

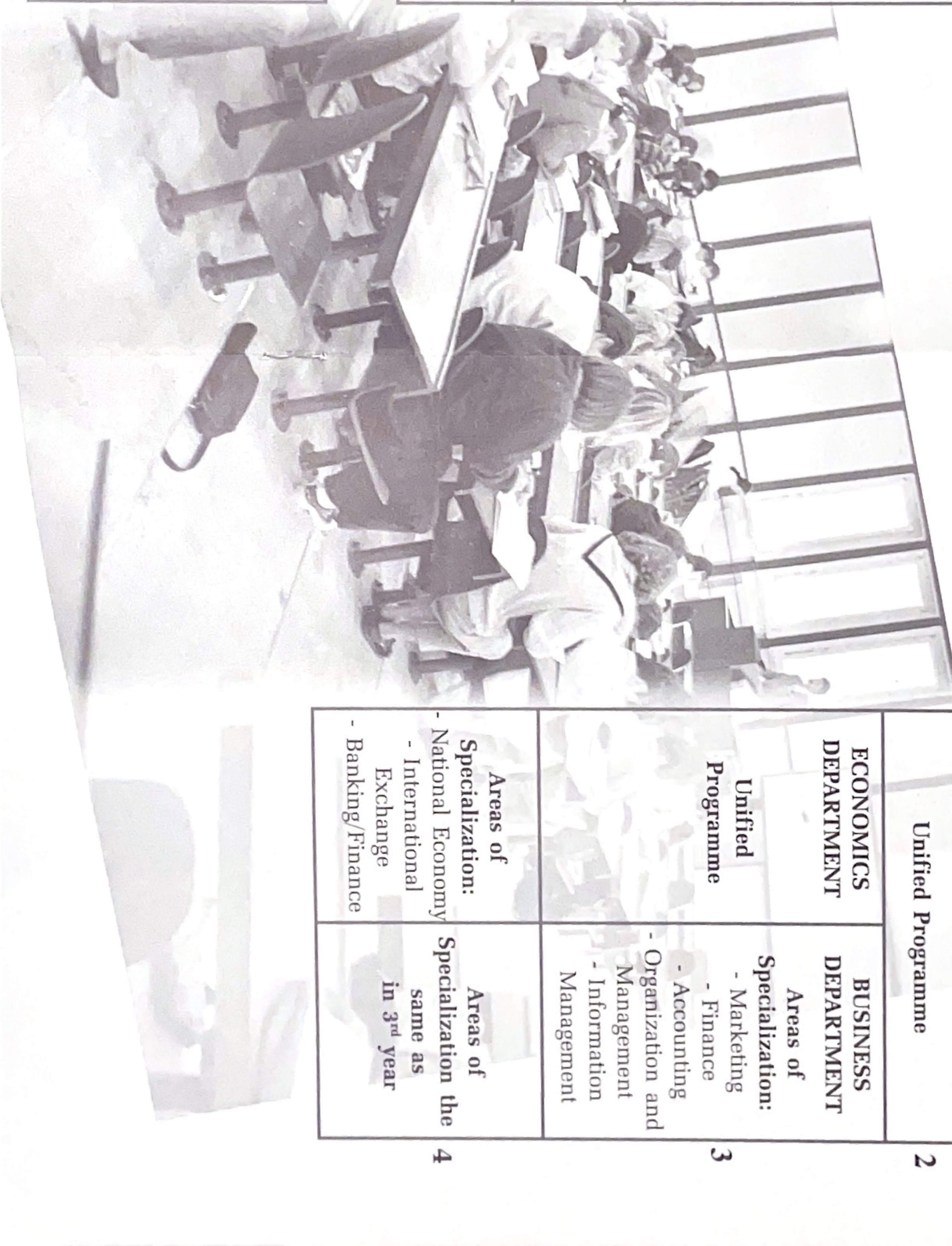

# Undergraduate Study

## FULL-TIME STUDY

The Faculty of Economics performs two separate programmes in full-time study:

- a four-year programme to acquire higher professional education - BUSINESS SCHOOL
- a four-year programme to acquire academic education - SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS

The programme of the SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS teaches students a more theoretical orientation of economics and they are trained either to perform work of high professional demand in research and analysis, or to manage companies and other organizations efficiently, as well as perform business operations at home and abroad.

The programme of the BUSINESS SCHOOL instructs students how to use their knowledge, analytical procedures and business techniques practically and immediately, and is closely connected to the problems of business practice. Not only does the programme develop its analytical possibilities, but it expressively develops negotiation and decision-making skills, and the realization of taken decisions on all professional and managerial levels in various types of economic and other organizations.

## PART-TIME STUDY

The Faculty of Economics advertises three separated programmes as part-time study:

- a four-year study programme to acquire higher professional education - BUSINESS SCHOOL
- a four-year study programme to acquire academic education - SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS
- a three-year study programme to acquire higher professional education - HOTEL INDUSTRY AND TOURISM

Part-time study is performed at the headquarters of the Faculty in Ljubljana and in study

groups outside Ljubljana. The programmes BUSINESS SCHOOL and SCHOOL OF ECONOMICS are equivalent to the full-time study.

The programme HOTEL INDUSTRY AND TOURISM is performed in cooperation with the Faculty of Biotechnology. The programme is organized on the basis of the needs analysis of catering industry and tourism, as one of the most promising economic fields, and its objective is to acquire higher professional education.

## DISTANCE LEARNING STUDY

Within the framework of a special PHARE project for regional cooperation, a centre, providing distance learning study in Slovenia, has been active at the Faculty of Economics since 1994. In the academic year of 1995/96 the Faculty of Economics is beginning to perform distance learning study experimentally in the first year of the BUSINESS SCHOOL in three study centres: Nova Gorica, Ptuj, Trebnje. In distance learning a student mostly studies independently, from specially prepared study materials. He can also communicate on-line, using computer network, and meet Professors and Tutors in study centres from time to time. The Faculty of Economics is a member of the international associations of distance learning EDEN and ICDE.





# Graduate Study

Within the framework of graduate study the Faculty of Economics performs five Master's Degree and four Specialist Degree graduate programmes. Graduate programmes enable students to acquire a Master's Degree or Specialist Degree title. Each year a larger and larger number of recognized Professors from foreign Universities are included in performing graduate studies besides the recognized domestic researchers and qualified professors.

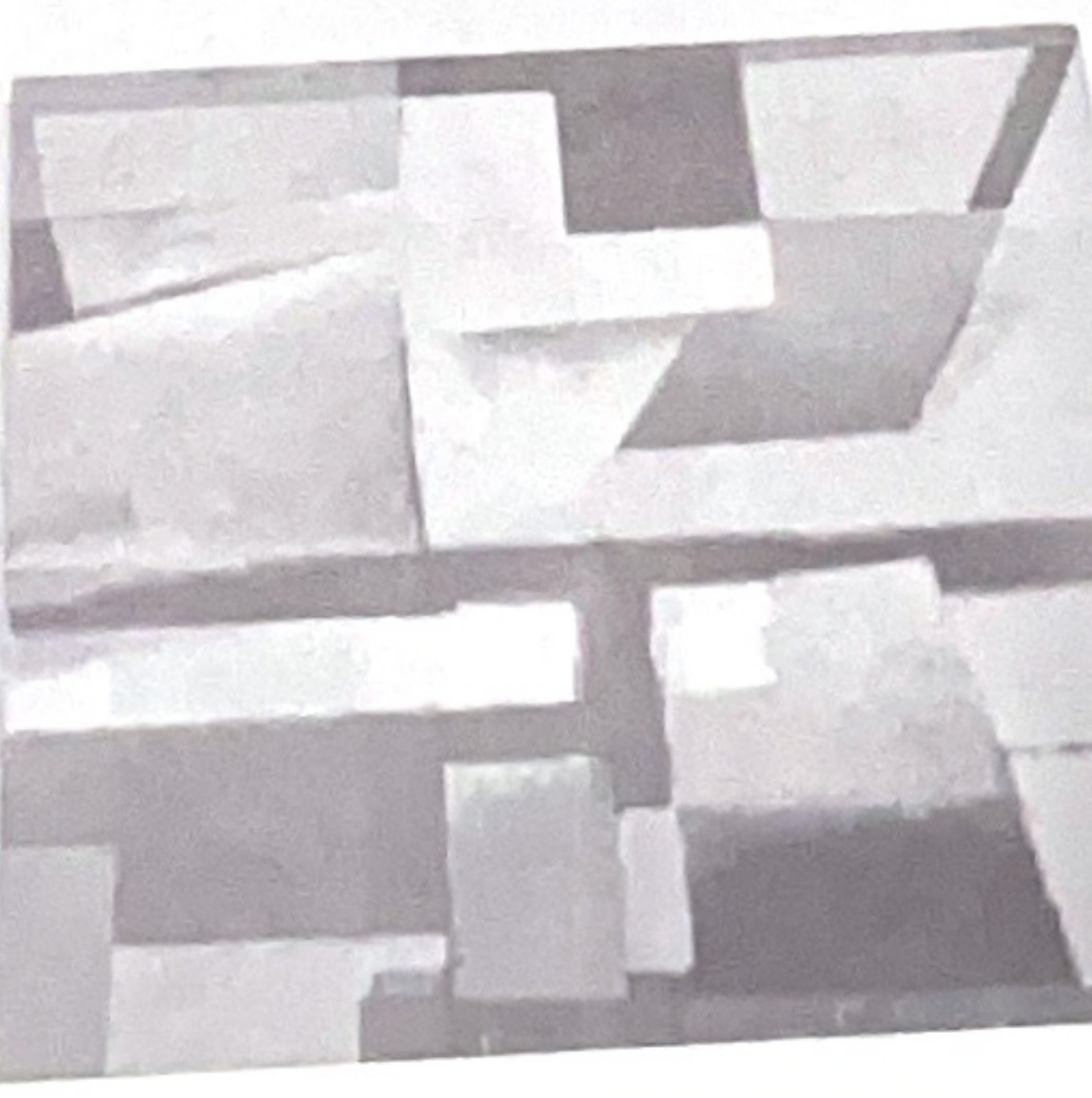

**MBA Resident Study.** Besides part-time graduate study, the Faculty of Economics also offers MBA Resident Study in the Educational Centre in Radovljica. The study is intended for present and future managers of profit and non-profit organizations. The study takes place mostly in English and provides four areas of specialization: General Management, Banking Management, Management in Insurance Companies, Hotel Management. In performing the programme, MBA Resident Study cooperates closely with the following universities: Universiteit Amsterdam, the Netherlands, University of Bristol, England, Cornell University, the USA, Indiana University, the USA, Kellogg, Northwestern University, the USA, University of Pittsburg, the USA, Tel Aviv University, Israel.

# Doctoral Study

The Faculty of Economics offers the opportunity to acquire a Doctor of Philosophy Degree in the fields of Economics, Business Administration and Information Management. A Doctor of Philosophy Degree can be awarded at the Faculty to candidates graduated in a four-year study of Economics or other study, holding a Master's Degree, or those who are authors of published important research work from the fields of Economics, Business Organization or Information Management. The education to acquire a Doctor of Philosophy Degree is organized in the form of consultancy work. Details of how to acquire a Doctor of Philosophy Degree are set out in the Regulation on Doctor's Dissertations.

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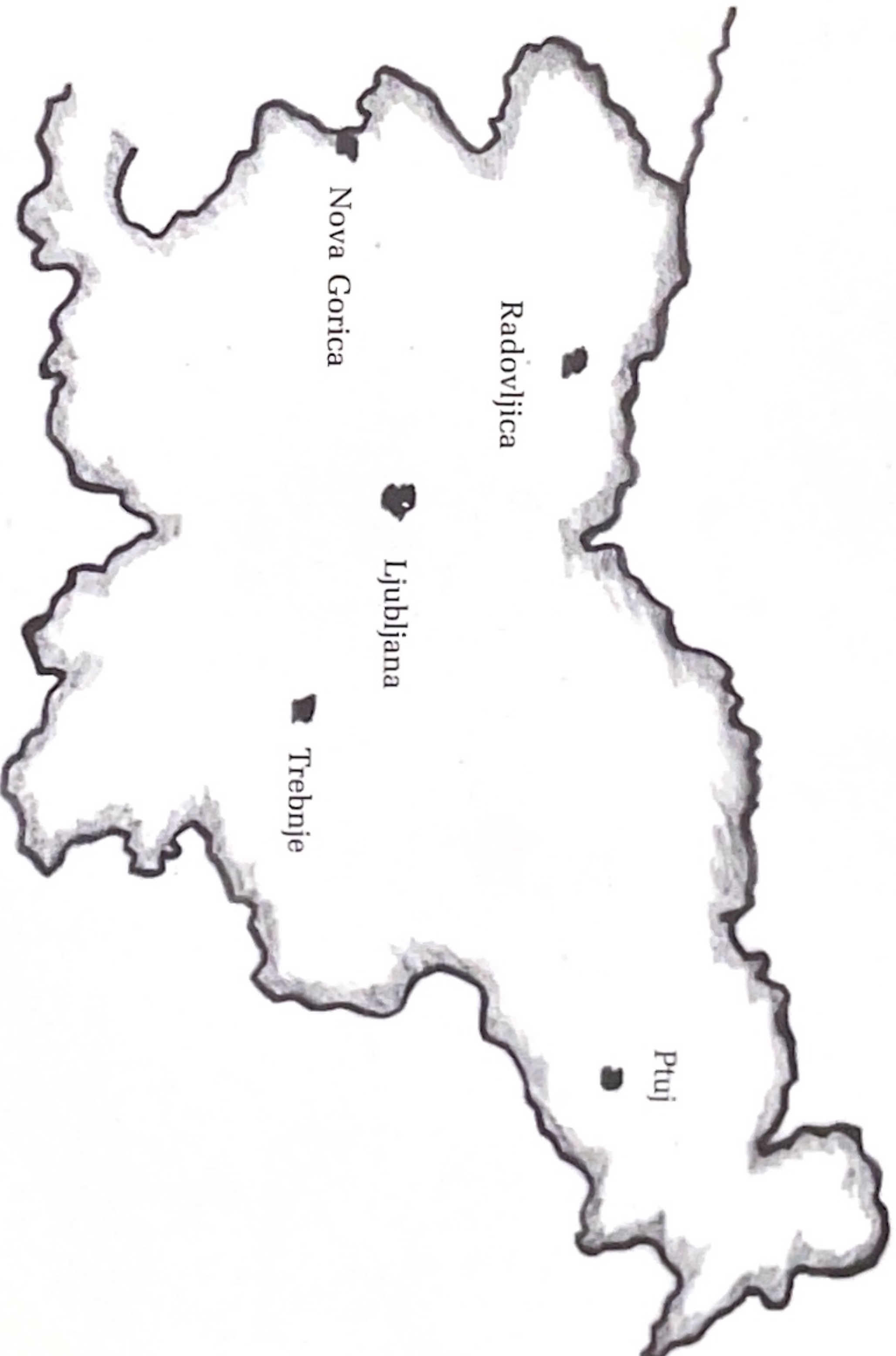
